## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65163 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Norton L. Smith of 3030 Upper Applegate Road, Jacksonville, Oregon 97530, phone 899-8341, for the use of the waters of Rock Gulch, a tributary of Applegate River, when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Rock Gulch to be made up by\* for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 2, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 170 feet South and 1070 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 9, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9; Diversion 2 - 1030 feet North and 1150 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, both in Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* appropriation from Applegate River,

Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 9 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.8 acre Irrigation Section 10 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 8.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 18, 1985** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19  $^{86}$  .
