## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65164** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Norton L. Smith of 3030 Upper Applegate Road, Jacksonville, Oregon 97530, phone 899-8341, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir, a tributary of Rogue River, constructed under Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 2, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **10.0 acre-feet stored water only**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1030 feet North and 1150 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson. Applegate Lake Dam is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4.5 acre-feet per acre from reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 3-07-10-W-0505 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 18, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
