PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65595** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Thomas W. Nevling and Tracy C. Harris of 7970 Bridgeview-Takilma Road, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and an unnamed stream, a tributaries of East Fork Illinois River,**
for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family, stock water and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second from the unnamed spring for domestic use, 0.005 cfs from the unnamed stream for stock water and 0.05 cfs from the unnamed stream for irrigation.**
that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 24, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.06 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 920.51 feet North and 12.0 feet East from the Southwest Corner of DLC 43; Diversion 2 - 1080.51 feet North and 40.0 feet East from the Southwest Corner of DLC 43, both being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 18, 1985** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86** .
