## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66052 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Laurie Wynn Johnson of 25475 Cape View Loop, Gold Beach, Oregon 97444, phone 247-2182, for the use of the waters of Walker Spring,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 530 feet North and 250 feet East from the Southwest Corner of NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 38 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 14 West, WM Section 7 NW 1/4 SE 1/43.15 acres

Domestic use for one family in—cluding the ir—rigation of not to exceed one—half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **january 18, 1985** reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
