PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66 I 00 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

This permit is issued to Colen L. Reinecker of 12645 Wilson River Highway, Tillamook, Oregon 97141, phone 842-2405, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Wilson River,

for the PURPOSE of aquaculture in steelhead egg incubation box

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 15, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10.0 gallons minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 910 feet North and 760 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 24, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township I South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I South, Range 9 West, WM Section 24 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Aquaculture

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 $^{\bf 36}$.
