PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 664 1 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jerry M. McCauley of 16800 Jones Road, Central Point, Oregon 97502, phone 826-7373, for the use of the waters of two unnamed streams and four reservoirs, to be constructed under Application R-66410, Permit R-9098, being 56.0 gallons per minute from for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 20, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 280.0 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Reservoir 1 - 750 feet South and 1100 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 2, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 35 South, Range 2 West; Reservoir 2 - 450 feet South and 1100 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 2, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 35 South, Range 2 West; Reservoir 3 - 1350 feet North and 1100 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 2, being** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Unnamed Stream 1 and 224.0 gpm from Unnamed Stream 2

within the NE I/4 SW I/4 of Section 35, Township 34 South, Range 2 West; Reservoir 4 — 1600 feet North and 1500 feet West from the N I/4 Corner of Section 2, being within the NW I/4 SW I/4 of Section 35, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 2 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 20.0 acres

Township 34 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 35 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 acres

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.0 acres

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 20.0 acres

Actual construction work shall begin on or before january 18, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
