PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **66602** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Nell M. Thuresson of Box 38, Cow Creek Road, Azalea, Oregon 97410, phone 837-3546, for the use of the waters of Cow Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 21, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1-1700 feet North and 40 feet East, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33; Diversion 2-280 feet South and 520 feet East being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, both from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 33, of Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 31 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 33 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 6.7 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 4.5 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.2 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.8 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the preper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before anuary 18, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
