PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **66603** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Victor Thumberg of Route 1, Box 186D, Carlton, Oregon 97111, phone 852-7757, for the use of the waters of Panther Creek, a tributary of Yamhill River, to make up for any deficiency in the available supply from an unnamed stream allowed under Permits 35610*** for the PURPOSE of **fish culture**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 21, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.08 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1300 feet South and 550 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

• **for maintenance of the reservoir constructed under Permits R-5570 and R-5729, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 25 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Maintenance of reservoir**

Provided the total quantity of water diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.08 cfs

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 18, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
