PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66903 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jarrold H. McKibben of 7270 Kings Valley Highway, Monmouth, Oregon 97361, phone 623-2003 for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir, constructed under Permit R-6633, a tributaries of Little Luckiamute River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 27, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 850 feet North and 390 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 36, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-6633.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 30, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986
