PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67949 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 67949 limitations and conditions:

Delbert C. Pitcher of Route 3, Box 742, Junction City, Oregon 97448, This permit is issued to phone 998-6463 for the use of the waters of Willamette Slough, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.69 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 2145 feet North and 330 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25; Diversion 2 -1500 feet North and 1670 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, both within Township 14 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 14 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 25 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 20.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.0 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 15.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 5.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986
