## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67950 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Delbert C. Pitcher of Route 3, Box 742, Junction City, Oregon 97448, phone 998-6463 for the use of the waters of Willamette Slough, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.80 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 330 feet South and 2010 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 5, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 4 West; Diversion 2 - 450 feet South and 2145 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 5, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 4 West; Diversion 3 - 575 feet North and 1895 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 32, being\*
A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 14 South, Range 4 West, WM, all in the County of Benton.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 30, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1 1986
