PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65503 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elmer E. Padberg of PO Box 395, Lexington, Oregon 97839, phone 989-8171, for the use of the waters of Willow Creek, tributary of Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 3, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 13.6 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2000 feet North and 1570 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 35, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 1 South, Range 25 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/60 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation in part the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 3, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
