PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65811** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Chester Bernhardt of PO Box 1151, Florence, Oregon 97439, phone 997-3714, for the use of the waters of an unnamed creek, a tributary of North Fork Siuslaw River,**

for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 30, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **75 feet North and 677 feet East from the Northwest Corner of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Lane.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 11 West, WM Section 24 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 3, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1985**. Extended to **Oct. 1, 1986**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1986**.
