## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66720 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dennis B. Logan, President of Western Empires Corporation, Route 2, Box 230, Irrigon, Oregon 97844, phone 481-2061, for the use of the waters of Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 23, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 800 feet North and 990 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, Township 5 North, Range 26 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 North, Range 26 East, WM NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10 40.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 3, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986
