PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66939 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles Austin Moore of Route 2, Box 273-A, Sheridan, Oregon 97378, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Beaver Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 28, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 460 feet North and 1410 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 5 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 South, Range 6 West, WM

Section 10 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one

Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 3, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
