## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66962 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond H. and Gail M. Potter of Route 2, Box 972, Prairie City, Oregon 97869, phone 820-3652, for the use of wastewater from a wastewater ditch, a tributary of John Day River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 29, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 60 feet South and 30 feet West from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32; Diversion 2 - 70 feet South and 270 feet East of the North 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32; Diversion 3 - 80 feet South and 550 feet East of the North 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, all in Township 13 South, Range 33\* A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* East, WM, in the County of Grant.
Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM Section 29 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 3, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986
