PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67358 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert and Norma Winkelman of Box 251, Mobley Drive, Azalea, Oregon, 97410, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Cow Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 7, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 860 feet North and 1140 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
