PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66706 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to USDI, Bureau of Land Management of 3040 Biddle Road, Medford, Oregon 97504, phone 776-4174, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary to Lincoln Creek and reservoir, to be constructed under Application R-66705, Permit R-9254, for the PURPOSE of livestock and wildlife

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 23, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.001 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2200 feet South and 1800 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 13, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 40 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South, Range 3 East, WM Section 13 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 livestock & wildlife

Actual construction work shall begin on or befor **February 13, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
