PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66708 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to USDI, Bureau of Land Management of 3040 Biddle Road, Medford, Oregon 97504, phone 776-4174, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir, tributary to Lost Creek, to be constructed under Application R-66707, Permit R-9255, for the PURPOSE of livestock and wildlife

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 23, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.001 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1320 feet South and 700 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 38 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 2 East, WM Section 3 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 livestock & wildlife

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 13, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
