## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65508 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 65508 limitations and conditions:

Tom E. and Paula A. Grigsby for the United States Deschutes Forest of This permit is issued to 7775 Hogston Road, Corvallis, Oregon 97330, phone 745-5780, for the use of the waters of the Metolius River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 15, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 425 feet South and 1718 feet West from the Northeast Corner, Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 15 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use including Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM Lot 36 Tract C the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 15, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
