PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67100 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Neal J. and Anna Dow of PO Box 125, Soledad, California 93960, for the use of the waters of John Day River, a tributary of Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 30, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.5 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 180 feet South and 2100 feet East from the Northwest Corner, Section 30, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 13 South, Range 32 East; Diversion 2 - 400 feet South and 460 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 25, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, WM, both in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 15, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
