## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67101 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 67101 limitations and conditions:

L. Bonnie Lopez of 307 South Humbolt Street/PO Box 524, Canyon City, Oregon 97820, phone 575-1795, for the use of the waters of Canyon Creek, a tributary of John Day River,

for the PURPOSE of

irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 30, 1983

0.01 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

40 feet North and 420 feet East from the W1/4 Corner, The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 40 leet North and 420 leet Last Itom the wift Corner, Section 1, being within the SW I/4 NW I/4 of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 14 South, Range 31 East, WM Section 1 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.25 acre NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.10 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19
