for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 3, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 730 feet South and 750 feet West from the Northeast Corner, Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 33 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden
