## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65271** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Charles Cruthers of Route 2, Box 278A, Milton Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-4500, for the use of the waters of a spring,**

for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for two families**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 21, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **725 feet North and 450 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 22, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 21, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19**85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19**86**.
