## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67717 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Carl and Betty Jane Sheedy of PO Box 536, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1936, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 560 feet South and 1240 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 5, being within Lot 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 5, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 32 East, WM Section 31 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 21, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
