PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67770 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elmer Stoler of 505 Morrow Road, Independence, Oregon 97351, phone 364-3570, for the use of the waters of Rickreall Creek, springs, and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-67769, Permit R-9309; being 1.06* for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 84.4 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.06 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 440 feet North and 3120 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29; Diversion 2 - 740 feet North and 1500 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29 within SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29; Pond and Springs - 400 feet North and 2500 West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29, being within the SW 1/4**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * cubic foot per second from Rickreall Creek with any deficiency in the available supply from Rickreall Creek, a tributary of Willamette River, to be made up by appropriation from the springs and reservoir,
- ** SE 1/4 of Section 29, all within Township 7 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9309 and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 21, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 , extended to 10-1-88
