## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67964 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Edward J. Eng of 4301 Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 90029, phone (231)666-4400, for the use of the waters of Columbia River,

 $^{\hbox{for the PURPOSE}}$  of  $\,$  domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 24, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 425 feet North and 985 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 17, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 North, Range 8 West, WM Section 17 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 21, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
