PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65335 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Wesley S. Shaner of 1478 Lexington, Astoria, Oregon 97103, phone 325-4981 and Roger Shannon of 2036 Manion Drive, Warrenton, Oregon 97146, for the use of the waters of an unnamed creek, a tributary of Nehalem River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 22, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 50 feet South and 400 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 4 North, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985
