## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65593 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert B. Lynch and Linda L. Lynch of PO Box 248, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-0808, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of John Day River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.16 gallons per minute for domestic and 10.59 gpm for irrigation of 2.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 24, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10.75 gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 450 feet North and 450 feet East from the Quarter Corner of Sections 19 and 24, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 15 South, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 15 South, Range 32 East, WM Section 19 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Spring use for domestic use for one family and 2.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before 42rch 2, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
