PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 6734] and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

LaVerne Haas of 5059 Old Melrose Road, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, This permit is issued to phone 672-4028, for the use of the waters of West Willis Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and stock use, being 0.03 cubic foot per second for irrigation of 24 % acres and 0.005 cfs for stock use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 4, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.035 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 400 feet South and 60 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, being within NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 21, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 21 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.4 acres Irrigation and

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
