PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67523 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clyde C. and D. Bud Combe of 6211 New Hope Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97527, phone 476-2812, for the use of the waters of Skunk Creek, a tributary of Applegate River, for the PURPOSE of stock water

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 12, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 90 feet North and 1225 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 13, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 13 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock water NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Stock water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985
