This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67524 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Terry C. Slider and Betty L. Slider of 965 W. 7th Street, This permit is issued to Florence, Oregon 97439, phone 997-7332, for the use of the waters of Woahink Lake,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 12, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 855 feet South and 1350 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 23, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
