PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67692 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond Kaser and Loretta A. Kaser of 1301 Pine, Silverton, Oregon 97381, phone 873-8106, for the use of the waters of Butte Creek,

for the PURPOSE of stock water

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1600 feet South and 780 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 16, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 1 East, WM Section 15 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Stockwater

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985
