PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **67732** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Larry B. Ellenwood of Route 4, Box 1131, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 679-6243**, for the use of the waters of **Ellenwood Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-67731, Permit R-9392**, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 10.0 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 13, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.8 acre-feet stored water only**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1820 feet South and 2250 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Daniel Huntley DLC 38, Section 34, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 27 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 27 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 5.0 acres
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.0 acres**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2.5** from storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9392,

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 6, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**
