PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67777 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to M.D. Martin, President, Omega Factors, of 11825 SW Greenburg Road, Tigard, Oregon 97223, phone 639-8812, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-67776, Permit R-9393, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and maintenance of reservoir for fire protection, being 0.04 cubic foot per second for irrigation of 3.4 acres and 0.01 cfs for maintenance of reservoir that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 600 feet South and 2230 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 21 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.4 acres irrigation and fire protection

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9393, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
