PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67890 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James T. Ernest of 34109 Johnson Landing Road, Scappoose, Oregon 97056, phone 543-6036, for the use of the waters of an unnamed drainage ditch and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-67891, Permit R-9394, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 75.8 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14. 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.93 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1170 feet North and 470 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 18, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18; Diversion 2 - 655 feet South and 130 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19; Flashboard Dam - 1285 feet North and 450 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 18, being within * A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18, all in Township 3 North, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Columbia.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9394, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
