PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65572 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Henry C.W. Inchumuk of Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, for the use of the waters of Montgomery Creek, an unnamed stream and two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-65571, Permit R-9396; being 0.12 cubic foot * for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 15.3 acres and maintenance of reservoir for stock water; being 0.31 cfs for irrigation and supplemental irrigation and 0.01 cfs for stock water. that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 9. 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.32 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATEDDiversion 1-180 feet South and 1275 feet East; Diversion 2-970 feet South and 1210 feet East, both from the Northwest corner of Section 27; both being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27; Diversion 3-1240 feet South and 960 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Section 27; Reservoir 1-1000 feet South and 530 feet West from the Northwest corner of Section 27; Reservoir 2-** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* per second from Montgomery Creek and 0.20 cfs from the unnamed stream and reservoirs, a tributary of Illinois River,

** 800 feet South and 500 feet West from the Northwest corner of Section 27; both being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, all within Township 38 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9396, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proposed state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 $\,$ 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
