## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66893 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bruno H. Hammari and Louise Hammari of Box 87-D, Star Route 1, Chiloquin, Oregon 97624, phone 783-2044, for the use of the waters of Agency Lake,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 0.85 acre

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 26, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 427.72 feet North and 792.4 feet West from the Quarter Corner of Sections 18 and 19, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 35 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 7 East, WM Section 18 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.85 acre Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986. Extended to October 1987
