PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66963 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Marc Valens of Moondance Ranch, Box 61, Beatty, Oregon 97621, for the use of the waters of Sycan River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 40.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 29, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 400 feet North and 330 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 34 South, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South, Range 11 East, WM Section 1 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 7.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 13.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 20.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
