PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67438 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gene Bleak of PO Box 768, Shady Cove, Oregon 97539, phone 435-1093, for the use of the waters of Rogue River and 9.0 acre-feet stored water from Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Permit R-8142,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 11.5 acres and maintenance of fire suppression system; being 0.0375 cubic foot per second from Rogue River and 9.0 af stored water from Lost Creek Reservoir for irrigation, and 0.01 cfs from Rogue * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 1, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0475 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 580 feet North and 1330 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* River for maintenance of fire suppression system

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 4-07-10-W0514 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
