PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67722 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mike and Julie Woodbury of PO Box 503, Canyon City, Oregon 97820, phone 575-0709, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and an unnamed draw, tributaries of John Day River; being 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring and 0.05* for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, and irrigation of 2.0 acres; being 0.01 cfs for domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Spring) - 1780 feet South and 50 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Section 5, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6; Diversion 2 (Draw) - 2030 feet South and 420 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 5, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 5, both within Township 14 South, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * cfs from draw,
- ** acre lawn and noncommercial garden from spring and 0.05 cfs for irrigation from unnamed draw

Township 14 South, Range 32 East, WM Section 6 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden
 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
