67728 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67728 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

Lane W. Tompkins of HC-83, Box 4101, Coquille, Oregon 97423, This permit is issued to phone 396-4787, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Coquille River (North Fork),

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 240 feet South and 1080 feet West the Interior 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 11 West, WM Section 33 NE 1/4 SW 1/4

Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
