PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67897 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Phillip M. Jones and Carol N. Jones of 5995 Teal Creek, Dallas, Oregon 97338, phone 787-3502 and Kenneth M. Balk and Jan Marie Schroeder of 5995 SW Teal Creek Road, Dallas, Oregon 97338, for the use of the waters of Teal Creek, a * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 32.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.4 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1150 feet South and 1430 feet East from the Northeast Corner of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28; Diversion 2 - 1450 feet South and 2770 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, both within Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* tributary of Little Luckimute River,

Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 28 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 5.8 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 12.6 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 11.95 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.65 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
