PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67919 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Harry Strain of 47721 Floras Loop, Langlois, Oregon 97450, phone 348-2489, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, Jim Creek and a reservoir, tributaries of Floras Creek, to be constructed under Application R-67918, * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 30.0 acres and stockwater, being 0.19 cfs from unnamed stream and 0.19 cfs from Jim Creek for irrigation and 0.002 cfs from unnamed stream and 0.003 cfs from Jim Creek for stockwater that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.385 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Reservoir - 100 feet South and 420 feet East; Unnamed Creek - 130 feet South and 240 East, both from the Northwest Corner of SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Permit R-9534, being 0.192 cubic foot per second from unnamed stream and 0.193 cfs from Jim Creek,

Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM Section 10 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 30.0 acres
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9534, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
