PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67956 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert P. Kidder and Julia W. Kidder of 996 Whistlers Lane, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 673-7761, for the use of the waters of North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 28.3 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1690 feet North and 730 feet East from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 16 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.3 acres
 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 20. acres

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
