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## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67971 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gilbert H. Wiley of Box 272, Mosier, Oregon 97040, phone 298-5980, extension 502, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of West Fork of Mosier Creek.

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one—half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 23, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1690 feet South and 1710 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 25, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North, Range 11 East, WM Section 25 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
