PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67992 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Roy Peters of Route 2, Box 160, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-2870, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Summers Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 21.08 acres, temperature control and flood harvesting of cranberries, being 0.53 cubic foot per second for irrigation, 1.5 cfs for temperature control and 1.0 cfs for flood harvesting, provided the total diverted * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 28, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1150 feet North and 1830 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 3, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
