PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66098 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert W., Carol L., Dwight A. and Gregory H. Ditty of Granite Route, Box 15, Sumpter, Oregon 97877, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of North Fork John Day River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 15, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 990 feet South and 40 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 3, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 35 1/2 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 35 1/2 East, WM Section 3 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use Block 14 Lots 3 and 4 Granite Townsite

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
