PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66957 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Straus Ranches of 10613 Table Rock Road, Central Point, Oregon 97502, phone 826-3126, for the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream 1, a tributary of Little Butte Creek, when available with any deficiency in the available supply from * for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 28.18 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 10, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Stream 1-400 feet South and 2200 feet West; Stream 2-1400 feet South and 2900 feet West, both from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Unnamed Stream 1 to be made up by appropriation from Unnamed Stream 2,

Township 36 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 10 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 9.63 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 12.9 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.15 acres

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Primary
4.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
