## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67542 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to E. Averitt Reed, Jr., of Route 4, Box 138, Cornelius, Oregon 97113, phone 357-3292, for the use of the waters of the an unnamed stream and reservoir, tributaries of Tualatin River to be contructed under Application R-67541, \* for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 13.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 21, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1700 feet North and 1200 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* Permit R-9585.

Township 1 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9585, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for stored water.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86
